Notice of Approval of Conservation Management Plan under 61K of the *Heritage Act 2004*

The ACT Heritage Council (the Council) has approved the “*Interpretation Strategy, Yarralumla Brickworks Precinct*” (Lovell Chen, 2022) as a Conservation Management Plan Addendum for the Yarralumla Brickworks and the Yarralumla Brickworks Railway Remnants (the Canberra Brickworks Precinct) on 7 September 2022.

In approving this Conservation Management Plan Addendum, the Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the conservation policies and actions contained therein will ensure the conservation and responsible management of the Canberra Brickworks Precinct.

This approval is current until 30 August 2026.

Conditions of Approval

The Council’s approval of this Conservation Management Plan Addendum is conditional, and sets out:

1. Further consideration is to be given to the *in situ* conservation and interpretation of BWR8, and this is to be delivered as part of the redevelopment unless it is demonstrated to the Council’s satisfaction that this outcome is not reasonably practicable;
2. Detailed information on interpretive outcomes is to be described as part of future development applications for the Precinct; and
3. The Council will make further comment on the designs for interpretive installations for the sites as these are presented.
